FIRST NCA NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited online only by 'One Time Registration' from qualified candidates belonging to the reservation communities of Kerala State for selection to the post mentioned below. Candidates who have already registered can apply through their profile. Those who have Aadhar, should add the same as ID proof in their Profile.

1. **Department** : **Excise**
2. **Name of post** : **Civil Excise Officer (Trainee)**
(Women Candidates and Differently Abled Candidates are not eligible to apply for this post)
3. **Scale of Pay** : **Rs. 20,000 – 45,800/-**
4. **Number of Vacancies** : **District wise**

Note:

- (i) Applications submitted by candidates belonging to the communities other than notified will be summarily rejected. No rejection memo will be issued.
- (ii)

Candidates who having applied with actual caste when the caste entry is differed in the SSLC book such changes to be published in the gazette notification and the same along with the Original community Certificate/Non Creamy layer certificate issued by the Revenue authorities, should be produced to prove their claim in application, at the time of verification.

- (iii) The above vacancies are now in existence. Ranked list will be prepared for each district in pursuance of this notification and shall remain in force until candidates are advised and appointed against the vacancies earmarked for the above communities, but remain unfilled due to paucity of candidates during the currency of the Ranked List published for the post as detailed below.

- (iv) The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on a revenue district basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O (Ms) No. 154/71/PD dated, 27.05.1971. A candidate advised for appointment in one revenue district from the Ranked List is not eligible for transfer to another district unless he completes 5 years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former district. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O(MS) No.4/61/PD dated, 02.01.1961. Candidates already in Government Service holding this post in any one district are prohibited from applying again for this post, but they can apply to higher posts when notified.
- (v) NCC Cadets having 'A' 'B' & 'C' Certificates will be given weightage marks at the rate of 2%, 3% and 5% respectively.

5. Method of Appointment : Direct Recruitment (from male candidates belonging to SCCC community only)

Note 1: In the case of direct recruitment, preference shall be given to Ex-servicemen.

2: Candidates appointed by direct recruitment will be on probation for a period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years and the candidates appointed shall undergo a training as may be prescribed by the Commissioner of Excise for a period of not less than 6 months, subject to the minimum of 180 working days. The period of training shall count for

probation and increment. Who did not undergo basic training within a period of two years and those who didn't successfully complete the basic training shall not be considered for further promotion.

6. **Age** : **19-34**. Candidates born between 2.1.1986 and 1.1.2001 are eligible to apply for this post (Both dates included).
(Including the age relaxation as per Para 2(i) of the General Conditions)
For other conditions regarding age relaxation, please see Para (2) of the General Conditions except Para 2(i) under Part II of this notification.

Note: In the case of those members belonging to scheduled castes who had converted to Christianity after adult age and their children are eligible for age relaxation upto 36 years. Such candidates should be born between 02.01.1984 and 01.01.2001(Both dates included).

7. **Qualifications :-**

- 1 Must have passed the Plus Two examination or its equivalent.

Note 1:KS & SSR Part II Rule 10(a)(ii) is applicable.

2.Candidates who have applied with equivalent qualification instead of qualification mentioned in the notification, should produce the relevant Government order to prove their qualifications equivalency at the time of verification.

- 2 **Physical**: Must not be less than 165 cms in height and 81 cms round the chest with a minimum expansion of 5 cms.

3 **Physique and Eyesight**

- (i) Must be certified by a Medical Officer to his physique fitness and capacity for active outdoor work. The Medical Certificate has to be produced as and when called for.
- (ii) Must be certified to possess the visual standards specified below without glasses

- (c) Each eye must have full field of vision, Colour blindness, squint or any other morbid condition of the eyes or lids of either eye will be deemed to be a disqualification
- (iii) Must be free from apparent physical defects like knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein, bow legs, deformed hands and limbs, irregular and protruding teeth, defective speech and hearing.
- (iv) Medical Certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon/Junior Consultant should be produced at the time of Physical Efficiency Test/Endurance Test and should be uploaded in their Profile at the time of Certificate Verification. A format of Medical Certificate is given below.

Note: Details regarding standards of vision should be clearly stated in the Certificate as given above and vague statement such as Vision Normal/good will not be accepted. Specification for each eye should be stated separately. If the specification are not as indicated above, the officer issuing the Certificate should certify whether the candidate has got better standards of vision or worse standards of vision as the case may be, otherwise the Certificate will not be accepted.

4. Endurance Test:- Must qualify in the Endurance Test of completing 2.5 kilometers race within 13 minutes.
5. Must qualify in any five events out of eight events specified below of the National Physical Efficiency Test (One Star Standard Test)

Note: The Physical measurement of candidates will be taken at the time of physical efficiency test and those who do not possess the prescribed physical measurement will not be admitted for the physical efficiency test. If accidents or injuries happen to a candidate while participating in the Physical Efficiency Test, he will not be given further chance to participate in the test.

8. Mode of submitting applications:-

Candidates must register as per 'ONE TIME REGISTRATION' with the official Website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz., www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have registered can apply by logging on

to their profile using their User-ID and password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply Now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be one taken on or after 31/12/2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link 'Applications' in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of their personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application, candidates must ensure correctness of the information they have entered. They must quote the User-ID for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Documents to prove qualification, Experience, Community, age etc. have to be produced as and when called for.

9. Appropriate Disciplinary action as per Rules of procedure Rule 22 shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc and submit confirmation for writing examination irrespective of whether they are present or absent for the examination.
10. Last date of submission of applications :**09.09.2020** Wednesday upto 12 midnight.
11. If Written Test/OMR Test/Online Test is conducted as a part of this selection candidate shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration Profile. Such candidates alone can generate and download the admission tickets in the last fifteen days till the date of test. The applications of candidate who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of admission tickets will be published in the examination calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.
