Applications are invited online only as per One Time Registration from qualified candidates for appointment in the undermentioned post in Kerala Government Service.

- 1 **Department** : Public Works/Irrigation
- 2 **Name of Post** : II Grade Overseer/Draftsman (Civil)
- 3 **Scale of pay** : ₹ 22200-48000
- 4 **Number of vacancies** : 12(Twelve)

The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancies if any reported to the Commission in writing during the period of currency of the list.

Note :- 3% of the vacancies for the post shall be reserved for differently abled candidates with Locomotor disability/Cerebral palsy, Hearing impairment, Low vision as per G.O(P)No.30/2013/SJD dated 04.04.2013.

- 5 **Method of appointment** : Direct Recruitment.
- 6 **Age limit** : 18-36. Only candidates born between 02.01.1984 and 01.01.2002 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post with usual relaxation to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Communities.
(For other conditions regarding the age relaxation please see para 2 of the General Conditions.)

7 Qualifications

Must possess any of the following qualifications

- (a) Group Certificates under K.G.T.E or equivalent Examination.

Note:- Group Certificates will include all the four groups viz. Building

Drawing, Building Construction, Survey and Irrigation.

OR

A pass in eight subjects, namely

- (i) Surveying and Levelling (Higher)
- (ii) Applied Mechanics (Higher)
- (iii) Building Material and Construction (Higher)
- (iv) Hydraulics and Irrigation (Higher)
- (v) Building Drawing and Estimating (Higher)
- (vi) Earth Work and Road Making (Higher)
- (vii) Geometrical Drawing (Lower) or Practical Plane and Solid Geometry (Lower)

AND

- (viii) Mensuration (Lower)

(b) Diploma in Craftsmanship in the trade of 'Draftsman (Civil)' or 'Surveyor' obtained after 18 months course (followed by 6 months practical training) at the Industrial Training Institutes/Centres conducted by the Government of India, Ministry of Labour.

Note :-

(1) Candidates who have successfully completed the Industrial Training of 18 months will also be treated as qualified even if they have not completed the period of practical training. But their appointments will be treated as provisional and will be regularised only after the completion of six months practical training.

(2) Diploma in Craftsmanship (Trade test certificate) in the trade of Draftsman (Civil) awarded to private candidates without insisting on six months practical training will be treated as an alternative qualification for direct recruitment to the post of II Grade Draftsman.

(c) Diploma in Civil Engineering (2 years course) of the Women's Polytechnics of the State.

Note (i) Rule 10(a)(ii) of Part II KS&SSR is applicable.

- (ii) Applications of candidates who have claimed qualifications equivalent to those prescribed in the Gazette Notification for the post will be considered equivalent only if they produce Government Order to prove equivalency at the time of verification.

- (iii) In the case of difference in original Caste/Community claimed in the application and that entered in SSLC book, the candidate shall produce a Gazette Notification in this regard, along with Non-Creamy Layer Certificate/ Community Certificate at the time of certificate verification.

8 Mode of Submitting applications:-

(a) Candidates must register as per “ONE TIME REGISTRATION” with the Official website of Kerala Public Service Commission www.keralapsc.gov.in before applying for the post. Candidates who have already registered can apply by logging on to their Profile using their User-ID and Password. Candidates must click on the 'Apply now' button of the respective posts in the Notification Link to apply for a post. The Photograph uploaded should be taken after 31.12.2010. Name of the candidate and the date of taking photograph should be printed at the bottom portion. The photograph once uploaded meeting all requirements shall be valid for 10 years from the date of uploading. There is no change in other instructions regarding the uploading of photographs. No application fee is required. Candidates shall take a printout of the application by clicking the link **Registration Card** in their profile. Candidates are responsible for the correctness of the personal information and secrecy of password. Before the final submission of the application on the Profile, candidates must ensure correctness of the information on their Profile. They must quote User-Id for further communication with the Commission. Application submitted is provisional and cannot be deleted or altered after submission. The application will be summarily rejected if noncompliance with the notification is found in due course of processing. Original documents to prove qualification, experience, age, community, etc have to be produced as and when called for.

(b) If Written/OMR/Online Test is conducted as part of this selection candidates shall submit a confirmation for writing the examination through their One Time Registration Profiles. Such candidates alone can generate and download the Admission Tickets in the last 15 days till the date of Test. The applications of candidates who do not submit confirmation within the stipulated period will be rejected absolutely. The periods regarding the submission of confirmation and the availability of Admission Tickets will be published in the examination Calendar itself. Information in this regard will be given to the candidates in their respective Profiles and in the mobile phone number registered in it.

(c) Appropriate disciplinary action as per Rules of Procedure Rule 22 shall be initiated against those candidates who submit applications with bogus claims of qualification regarding education, experience etc. and submit confirmation for writing the examination, irrespective of whether they are present or absent for the examination.

(d) Candidates who have AADHAAR Card should add AADHAAR Card as I.D. Proof in their Profile.
